

How to write a good bio...

Bios are due one month prior to performance

Requirements for your biography:

- 1. Your name is always first, with your role following in parentheses
- 2. It is to be written in the first person (I/Me)
- 3. Please share what graduating class/grade you are in
- 4. 400 words or less

Things to keep in mind when writing your bios:

- 1. You may want to include past credits (shows) you have been in at Lakeland and/or other places
- 2. List any academics you may love, after school activities, hobbies of interest, etc.
- 3. Feel free to put any special awards you have received
- 4. Shout outs/thank you's to parents, friends, teachers, etc.
- 5. Share your future plans if you are Graduating
- 6. Remember to keep them school appropriate and always be kind to others
